Have we got a project for you!

We have some unforeseen expenses for this summer.

First: For the past several years we have used *Keys for Kids* with the children at Good News Day Camp during our quiet time each day. Then the children may take their *Keys for Kids* home with them on Friday. Our hope is that for the next three months the children will continue to have a quiet time with the Lord; growing in their knowledge of the One True God. *Keys for Kids* has started a new ministry called *Keys for Camp*. We are excited about this because this will open the door for the children who attend Good News Day Camp to received the *Keys for Kids* every three months throughout the next year, with a cover that has the CEF Good News Day Camp logo on the front and which includes contact information for the local CEF office and several of it's ministries: Mailbox ClubTM, Good News Club[®] a letter from the local director and some fun camp pictures. We are praying for full weeks of camp which would increase our camp enrollment to 325 children. The cost for the *Keys for Kids* for the year is \$1,650. If you would like to give a donation towards this project please include a note specifying *Keys for Kids*.

Second: We are excited to have a new Good News Day Camp starting at Primrose Bible Church (outside Minersville) the week of July 17. In order to reach as many children as possible in the town of Minersville we are planning on a bulk mailing to each resident within the town limits and to have several bus pickups. The cost for the bus is \$100. per day (\$500. for the week) We are thanking God for the bus driver who is donating her time in order to keep the cost down. Also, will be the cost of the mailing which at this time is unknown (estimating at least \$100.) If you would like to donate towards the cost of the Minersville Camp, please include a note designating Minersville day camp.

<u>Third</u>: This one's not so glamorous as the first two but extremely necessary! Due to septic issues for the Youth Retreat we are again renting Port-a-Johns for the weekend with sink capabilities. The cost for the weekend is \$500. Again, if giving specifically towards this need mark Youth Retreat on a note sent in with the check.
