At one time, should a child have questions about the Gospel, there was a counselor available to speak with them. Over the years, we lost the volunteers to counsel the children, but Linda remained faithful to record the story. When there were times she was unavailable, my mom, Nancy Guitas, would fill in for her.

Well, times change and the calls to the Tel-A-Story® became less and less. God worked in CEF of Washington to develop a Tel-A-Story® with all the stories prerecorded. Children even have the option to listen to the story online. At different times there are counselors available to speak with the children and if a counselor is not available there is a pre-recorded Gospel message.
