n a recent interview about his book, Is God Real?, Lee Strobel said that it was found that "200 times a second around the clock, someone on Planet Earth is typing into a search engine, basically the question: Is God Real?"

This is why this ministry is not only for the seeking unbelieving child, but also for the seeking believing child. I am praying, and I ask you to pray also, that God will send many seeking children to our camps this summer.
