

December 2025 ~ Prayer and Praise

1. Mon. Praise God for all the *Good News Club*[®] volunteers.
2. Tues. Pray "*that the word of the Lord may have free course and be glorified*" (II Thes.3:1) through the churches.
3. Wed. Pray for children to complete their Mailbox Club[™] lessons without reminders. Praise God for Janet Kramer and Lori Steffy who grade the lessons and send each child personal notes, and of course, stickers.
