1. Wed. The spring semester of *Good News Club*[®] is coming to an end. Pray for the children to remember the Bible lessons they were taught.
2. Thu. Remember. *“But Jesus remained silent. And the high priest said to Him, ‘I adjure You by the living God, tell us if You are the Christ, the Son of God.’ Jesus said to him, ‘You have said so.
